If you are an authorised account holder from outside the Commonwealth of Australia, personal information you provide will be transferred, stored and processed within the Commonwealth of Australia subject to the [Privacy and Data Protection Act 2014 \(Vic\)](#) (“PDP Act”) and the [Privacy Act 1988 \(Cth\)](#). (“PA Act”).

Information that may be collected from all access of the Site may consist of but not limited to:

- Network location and IP address and associated network information;
- The date and time of your visit to our website <http://www.antiquaorbis.com>;
- The types of web browser (e.g. Palemoon, Brave, Google Chrome, Safari etc) and operating system (e.g. Linux Distribution, Windows 10, Mac OS X etc.) you are using;
- Antiqua Orbis Clients accessed;
- Screen resolution and screen colour processing ability;
- Referring site details (such as the URL that you came through to arrive at our website);
- Page visited and the time spent on each page;
- Documents downloaded and search terms used;
- The forms accessed on our website;
- Personal identifiable information;
- Unique device identifier;
- Cookies and data about which page you visited;
- Device information, hardware model, operating system information, app version, app usage, debugging information, browser information, Client usage, third-party access to Clients;
- Geo location information (if enabled by user); and
- Will assign a unique user identifier

Account holders purchasing products or services will be required to provide additional information such as a valid credit card number, expiration date, and shipping and billing addresses.
